Rheinmetall Mission Master CXT2 with Oerlikon Skyranger 762: the Robotic Combat Force Multiplier for Ultra-Short Range Air Defence

Current conflicts show that ground-based air defence has regained importance in military operations. At DSEI 2025, Rheinmetall will present the Mission Master CXT Skyranger 762, an unmanned ground vehicle (UGV) for Ultra-Short Range Air Defence. It combines the capabilities of the proven Skyranger family with Rheinmetall's state-of-the-art autonomous ground system capabilities.

The Mission Master CXT2 is the next generation of the Mission Master family. It offers state-of-the-art Unmanned Ground System (UGS) technology to

overcome extreme terrain and even water obstacles. At the same time, it can transport heavy loads of up to 1,000 kilograms. This makes it a versatile robotic combat force multiplier on today's and tomorrow's battlefields.

The Oerlikon Skyranger 762 is a remote-controlled weapon station for Ultra-Short Range Air Defence (U-SHORAD). It is also suitable for countering unmanned aerial systems (C-UAS) – in particular the dreaded small drones (NATO Class I). The Skymaster C2 suite enables seamless connection with other Skyranger, Skynex or Skyspotter air defence systems. The Mission Master CXT Skyranger 762 can be operated by just one person, saving resources. Training requirements are minimal. The compact and cost-effective Oerlikon Skyranger 762 is equipped with all-weather sensors and uses the widely used and proven M134D Gatling machine guns in 7.62 mm x 51 calibre as its main armament. If required, the Mission Master CXT Skyranger 762 can provide effective fire support in ground combat.

The Skyranger 762 is part of the proven Rheinmetall Oerlikon Skyranger family. This offers state-of-the-art mobile air defence, combining high-precision cannon systems, advanced sensors and seamless integration into the battlefield. With customisable armament options – including 35 mm and 30 mm revolver cannons – and modular sensor configurations, Skyranger adapts to different tactical requirements while providing effective protection against current and future airborne threats.
