Total investment of almost €500 million

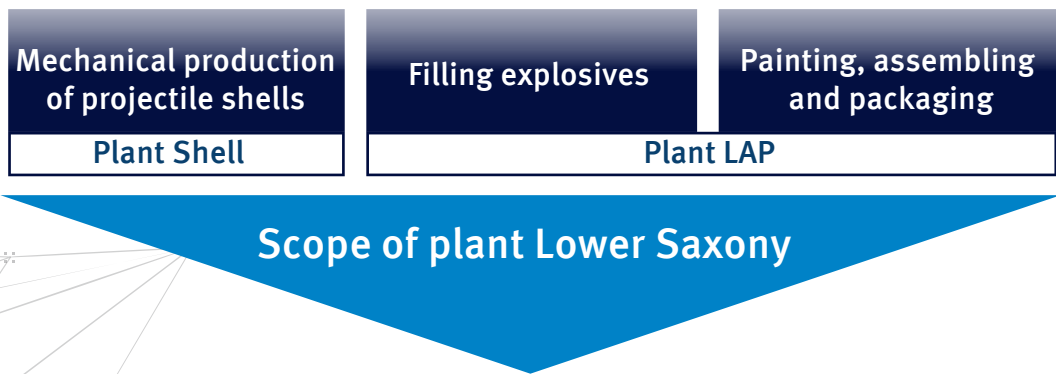
TAKING RESPONSIBILITY IN A CHANGING WORLD

Current situation

- Artillery remains a key combat capability in the 21st century
- The German Armed Forces and NATO intend to purchase significant quantities of 155 mm artillery ammunition for the long term
- Production capacities in the Western world are currently insufficient to meet this demand
- To date, only small quantities of artillery ammunition have been produced independently in Germany
- Rheinmetall is making significant investments, the ground-breaking ceremony for the new factory site took place in February 2024
- The construction of the 'Plant Lower Saxony' was completed in record time and received extensive support from local authorities
